Team composition: Maximum 18 players and 2 goalies \& minimum 11 players and 1 goalie, all licensed, born in 2009, 2010 and 2011 ( passport/ID card obligatory)

## IIHF Regulations

Penalties: 1 minute

## NO CHECKING

Teams must present themselves at the edge of the ice 5 minutes before the start of the matches. In case of delay, the offending team will be penalized with a goal against for the meeting to follow.

## IF THE TOURNAMENT DOES NOT RUN ON TIME: THE CLOCK RUNS CONTINUOUSLY. IDEM IF MORE THAN 5 GOALS DIFFERENCE BETWEEN TEAMS.

Warm-up: 2 minutes without a puck before the match. Break 2 minutes between each half.
Pool matches: Championship formula
Each 15' period counts for a match
Victory: 2 points - Draw: 1 point - Defeat: 0 point
Change on the fly
Matches are $2 \times 15$ minute periods with the clock stopped for every pause in the game.. In the event of a tie, in the general classification, the teams will be divided according to the following criteria, taken in order: the direct result between these teams then the general goal-average, then the best attack and lastly the one that has had the least penalty minutes.

Final stages: Classic matches of 2 periods of 15 minutes with the clock stopped for every pause in the game.
Compulsory winner. In the event of a tie at the end of normal time: 3 penalty shots ( + sudden death (each shot taken by a different player)

Protests: Claims must be submitted in writing directly after the end of a match to the Tournament Committee ( $50 €$ non-refundable protest fee). Any complaints will be dealt with by the Board of Appeal composed of 3 members of the CHC and it alone will be empowered to take decisions. Any decision of the protest committee shall be final. This committee also reserves the right to suspend or disqualify any player or leader of a team that behaves contrary to sportsmanship both on and off the ice.

Closing Ceremony: After each ranking match the best player (either player or goalkeeper) of each team will be announced

Important Reminder: Only Leaders, Coach, \& Players are allowed to be on the bench.
